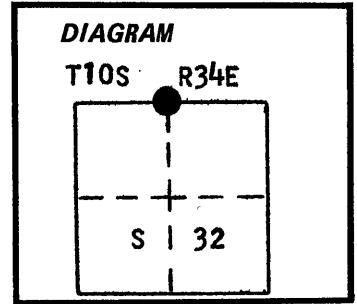


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Bamford Robb and Herman D. Graddon under joint GLO contract number 383, dated March 26, 1881
Surveyor General record states:



Set stone 14x10x6 ins for 1/4 sec cor from which:

- A pine 20 in dia bears S30W 58 lks dist
- A pine 16 in dia bears N55E 106 lks dist

Grant County survey number 64 calls finding the bearing trees, but no corner stone

Description of corner evidence found:

Found both original bearing trees as described below

No corner stone found

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: At corner position determined from the bearing trees, I set a 2 1/2'x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 28 inches in the ground from which:

Original bearing trees

- A 38 inch diameter P.Pine bears N58°E 70.4 feet, blaze evident, live and vigorous, did not open
- A 35 inch diameter P.Pine bears S30°W 35.9 feet scribes visible live, but leaning severely

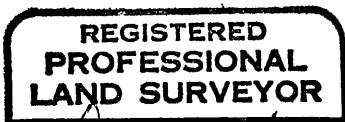
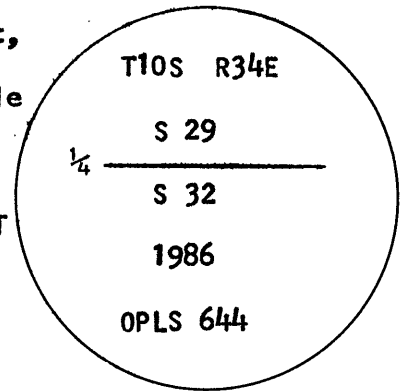
New bearing tree

- A 9 inch diameter P.Pine bears S30°E 31.15 feet marked 1/4 S32BT

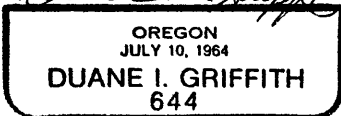
Raised mound of stone around monument

- Set steel fencepost approximately 5 feet East with 54-4 sign
- Corner set April 1, 1986

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of these accessories. I used 20° East magnetic declination and the distances to the original BTs are to the face of the blaze and the distances to the new BT is to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the tree at the root crown. I set a brass washer marked OPLS 644 at the BT blaze.
