

TOWNSHIP 14, South, range 35 East.

Continued

NW Corner, Section 5

Found original marked stone in old mound. The distance to it from  $S\frac{1}{4}$  Cor. Sec. 31, T 13 S, R 35 E checks well.

The 38" yellow pine is in good condition, but it is  $8^{\circ} 30'$  South of due west, hence bears  $S 81\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W$  instead of  $S 8^{\circ} 30'$  West as recorded. Also, the distance is 230 links instead of 130 links as recorded.

I scribed 13" Y. Pine S 31 W 27.9 ft. S6 BT

17" Y Pine S 29 E 53.0 ft. S5 BT and put tag on second tree.

$N\frac{1}{4}$  Corner Sec. 5

I was unable to find proof of original stone  $15 \times 10 \times 8$  with  $\frac{1}{4}$  on north face, but found windfall 48" Y Pine with original scribe face down.

hence, I set new stone  $24 \times 15 \times 12$  with  $\frac{1}{4}$  on South in big stone mound by reversing original BT bearing and distance ( S 54 W 46 lks.) from BT origin.

I scribed:

14" Juniper S 38 W 54.0 ft. " $\frac{1}{4}$ " S 5 BT"  
18" Y. Pine S 13 E 135.0 ft. " $\frac{1}{4}$ " S 5 BT"

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
