

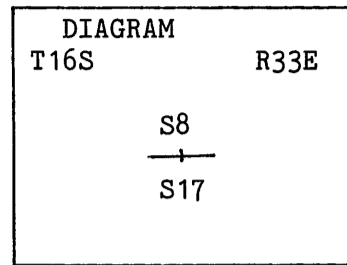
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Original corner set by Henry W. Cook under contract number 488 dated August 11, 1883.

Page 111 of the government field notes state:

3992 Set a basalt stone 18 x 14 x 10 ins 12 ins in ground for 1/4 sec cor marked 1/4 on N face from which  
 A pine 40 ins dia bears N78°E 49 lks dist marked 1/4S BT  
 A pine 40 ins dia bears S80°E 55 lks dist marked 1/4S BT



No record of subsequent remonumentation found in county records.

Description of corner evidence found:

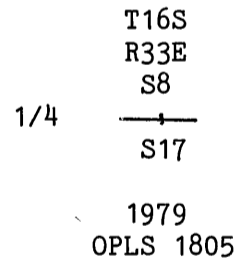
A stone 19" x 14" x 9" marked 1/4 on N face from which:

A 32" DBH PP stump bears N78°E 49 lks. (to face) scribed 1/4S BT.  
 A 28" DBH PP stump bears S80°E 55 lks. (to face) scribed BT.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 30" long 2-1/2" dia. iron pipe with brass cap marked:  
 20" in ground & raised a mound of stones flush with the top of the new monument. I buried the original stone on the North side of the new monument, upside down and flush with the ground. from which I scribe NEW BEARING TREES:

A 9" DBH PP bears N33°W 34.0 ft., scribed 1/4 S8 BT.  
 A 16" DBH PP bears S59-1/2°W 20.6 ft., scribed 1/4 S17 BT.



Painted faces & bands around BT's red & attached BT & Attention tags.  
 Drove a 6 Ft. long steel fence post 2.2 Ft. in ground 7.4 Ft. N of corner & attached an attention tag to it.  
 Used steel tape & magnetic staff compass with 20° East variation, measuring to the center of the new BT's.  
 This corner was set August 21, 1979.
