

History of 1974 BLM Remonumentation

The cor. of secs. 24 and 25 only, on the E. bdy. of T. 7 S., T. 35 E., monumented with the remains of the original corner tree, a lodgepole pine snag, 6 ins. diam., with scribe marks E S24 visible on open blaze on NW. face; 4 notches on N. face, and 2 notches on S. face, from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A root hole, bears N. 30° W., 9 lks. dist., with a down and decayed lodgepole pine alongside, 6 ins. diam., with axe marks visible on decayed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, and directly beneath the remains of the original corner tree, with brass cap mkd.
