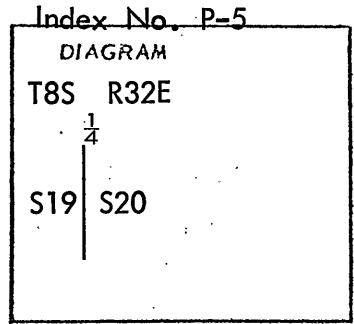


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Herman D. Gradon under contract No. 499 dated March 11, 1884. The notes state that at the corner position a marked basalt stone 12x14x4" was set 12" in the ground from which:

- A 12" Pine bears N88°E 88 Lks (58.1 ft) marked 1/4 SBT
- A 30" Pine bears N5°W 44 Lks (29.0 ft) marked 1/4 SBT



No record of subsequent remonumentation found in County Records .

Description of corner evidence found:

The corner position was re-established from the BT's. A stone 24x12x4" with possible marks was found laying in the bottom of a dry stream bed 3 1/2 to 4 feet down stream from the re-established corner position.

From the re-established corner position:

- A 37 1/2" Pine bears N6°W 29.0 feet scribed 1/4 SBT
- A 16" Pine snag bears N89°E 58.1 feet scribed 1/4 SBT

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the corner position a 2 inch by 30 inch iron pipe, with brass cap marked as shown, was set 20 inches in the ground and surrounded with a mound of stones to the cap.

Set a steel fence post South of the corner and attached sign No. 54-4.

Established 2 new BT's:

- A 17 1/2" Pine bears S5°W 11.9 feet scribed 1/4 S19BT
- A 16" Red Fir bears N69°E 66.3 feet scribed 1/4 S20BT

New BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54-3 and 54-4 to all BT's and painted a red ring around the trees above the upper blaze.

Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 19 1/2° east declination. Measured to center of Bts.

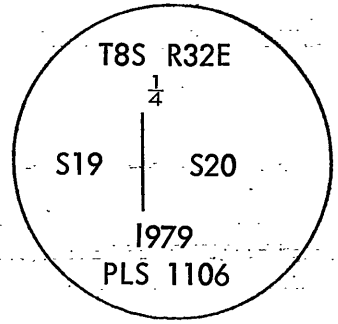
