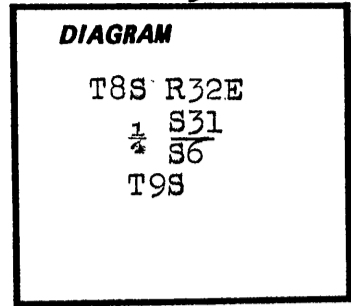


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Z-3

**History of original corner establishment:**

Herman D. Gradon under G.L.O. Contract No. 416, dated Aug. 19, 1881, set a basalt stone 14"x 8"x 6", 9" in the ground. Stone was marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on north face. He raised a stone mound alongside.



**Description of corner evidence found:**

I found a stone 14"x 9"x 7" lying loose approx 2 ft. north of fence corner; fences running south, east and west. No marks were evident on stone and none of stone mound remains. This location fits call to creek to the west.

**Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:**

In place of the original stone I set a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x 30" alum. pipe with a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " alum. cap marked:  
 Monument is 16" in ground and surrounded by a mound of stone. Original stone is buried alongside.

- A Ponderosa Pine, 14" dia., S70°E, 117.0 ft.; marked:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S6 BT
- A Ponderosa Pine, 23" dia., N30°E, 76.8 ft.; marked:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S31 BT
- A Ponderosa Pine, 18" dia., N40°E, 107.7 ft.; marked:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S31 BT
- A Ponderosa Pine, 11" dia., N16°W, 122.7 ft.; marked:  $\frac{1}{4}$  S31 BT

BTs have blaze and a 6" band painted red, BT tags, "Land Survey Monument" signs and alum. "PLS 1832" washers nailed to the bottom of the blaze. There is a 6' steel fence post with a "Land Survey Monument" sign within 5' of the corner.

Measured to center of BTs using steel tape and staff compass. Magnetic declination set at 19°E.
