- Found axle set in concrete, at section corner.
- O Set 5/8"x 30" iron pin with attached yellow plastic cap marked BGA SURVEY MARKER.
- Found monument from Recorded Survey No. Survey No. appears in the box.

NARRATIVE: This survey was performed at the request of Lee Wilson, acting in behalf of the Blue Mt. Hospital District. The purpose of this survey was to locate and monument the east boundary of the Blue Mt. Hospital tract.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate existing monuments. New monuments were set in accordance with the evidence found and at deed record, as shown hereon.

I held the deed record distance from the NW corner of Section 26 to the northeast corner of the hospital tract, I then held the record bearing of S.0°10'00"W., to intersect the north sideline of Ford Road.

I located the remainder of the east boundary at deed record and at Record Map of Survey No. 1129 record, based on the two centerline monuments found on Ogilvie Drive.

I found no unusual conditions with this survey.
