



NARRATIVE:
 This survey was performed at the request of Jim Walker, Assistant Road Supervisor, acting in behalf of the Grant County Road Department.
 The purpose of this survey was to locate the proposed property adjustment lines, shown hereon.
 A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate existing monuments of Record Survey No. 1138, existing fence lines and the existing rock quarry site as shown. The county acquired title to the E1/2NE1/4NW1/4SW1/4 of Section 17, Twp. 18S., Rg. 32E., W.M. by deed from the State of Oregon, dated Mar. 29, 1994, recorded April 4, 1994 as Instrument No. 940630, County Deed Records.
 To delineate the boundary lines of the county's land, as described would require the subdivision by survey of Section 17. We did endeavor to do this. The problem is that virtually all of the section and 1/4 section corners of Section 17 are lost. We searched for every one of them. We also searched for selected corners of Section 16, with no success. The nearest found corner is the S1/4 corner of Section 15, which we tied this survey to. In the interest of economy and with my recommendation to the Road Department, it was decided to propose this property line adjustment to the adjoining property owners.
 The proposed property adjustment lines shown hereon are about the same dimensions as the title lines, if the section were found to be 1 mile square, and allowing for the county road right of way. The position of this survey approximates the position of the title lines within this section. This is based on existing fence lines and the tie to the S1/4 corner of Section 15.
 New monuments were set at corners of the property adjustment lines at locations approved by Mr. Walker, as shown.
 Record Survey No. 1138, which I performed in 1990, delineates the right of way lines for County Road No. 73.

Point being 1888.35 ft. North and 11999.29 ft. West of the S1/4 corner of Section 15, T18S, R32E, W.M. The S1/4 corner is monumented with a 2" aluminum pipe with attached brass cap, OPLS 1805.
