- Found monument, see record survey number shown in the box.


NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Jim Lound. The purpose of this survey was to monument a proposed property line adjustment for Mr. Lound's property.

After searching the available records pertaining to this survey, I found that the section had been subdivided during survey number 324 and that the right of way for County Road No. 74—H had been monumented during survey number 1047. The NW corner of the NE1/4NE1/4SW1/4 of Section 33 was set during survey number 528. I found the monuments appurtenant to this survey in good condition and excepted them as shown hereon. I monumented the proposed adjusted property line according to Mr. Lound's instructions.

This survey was performed with a Topcon GTS-4 total station, with a closed loop random traverse.
