BASIS OF BEARINGS

- Found 2½" brass cap set in concrete 12" below street surface in a cast iron monument box.
- Found 1/2" iron pin, see North Heights Subdivision.
- O Set 5/8"x30" iron pin with attached red plastic cap marked CORNERSTONE SURVEYING, INC.

NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Otis Cummings. The purpose of this survey was to Survey and monument a proposed property adjustment line.

I found the original monuments at the Initial Point of North Heights Subdivision and at the SW and NE corners of the subdivision, I accepted these monuments. I also found a monument at the SW corner of Lot 7, which is shown on Survey No. 99, which I accept. The distance for each lot along the west boundary of the subdivision was proportioned between the three found monuments as shown. I also found and accepted the two street centerline monuments. I used the bearing between the NW corner and the NE corner to establish the direction of each lot line and intersected the west side line of Boulder Lane at 25 feet from the centerline monuments. The proposed property adjustment line was established as directed by Mr. Cummings.
