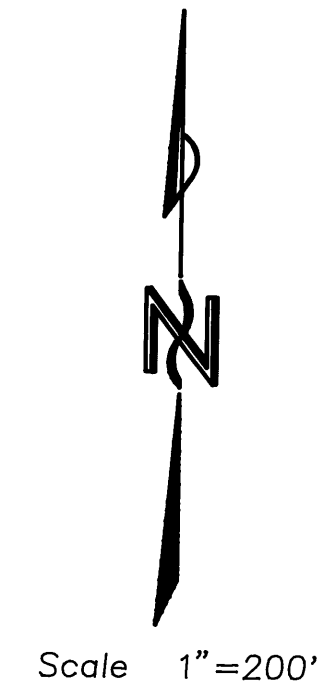


Point being 697.20 ft. South and 717.50 ft. West of the NE corner of Section 12, T9S, R27E, W.M. Which is monumented with a 1½" iron pipe and Grant County Surveyor brass cap.

NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Harold Reynolds. The purpose of this survey was to monument the existing fence line to establish a definable boundary.

The basis of bearings was determined using static GPS receivers. The GPS measurements were made in NAD 83, Oregon North Zone. The state plane bearings were rotated clockwise 00°45'21" to true north at the NE corner of Section 12, T9S, R27E. All Bearings are relative to this local north meridian.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate the highway centerline stripe and the existing fences shown hereon. I set a monument 40 feet from the existing highway centerline and in the fence line running easterly. The fence line is generally straight to the west for 1773 feet. Then turns to follow a dike along Cottonwood Creek and various ditches.

The Section subdivisional lines were not determined in this survey and are shown in their approximate positions.
