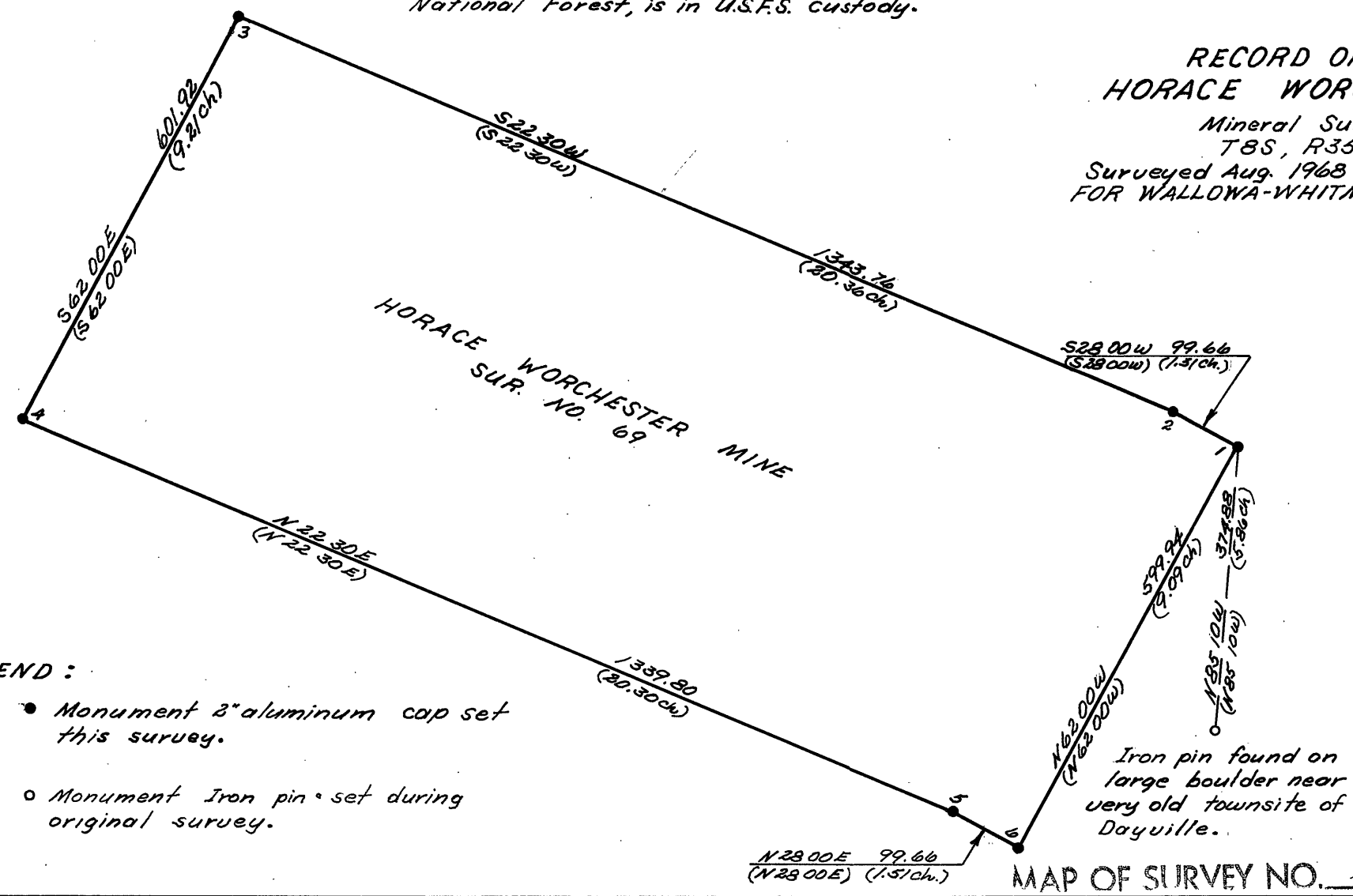


Meridian by Solar Observation
