A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate existing monuments. New monuments were set in accordance with the evidence found.

The 3/4" iron pipes found are unrecorded. The record shows that 5/8"x30" iron pins were set in 1972 (Survey No. 282) I don't know who set the iron pipes.
