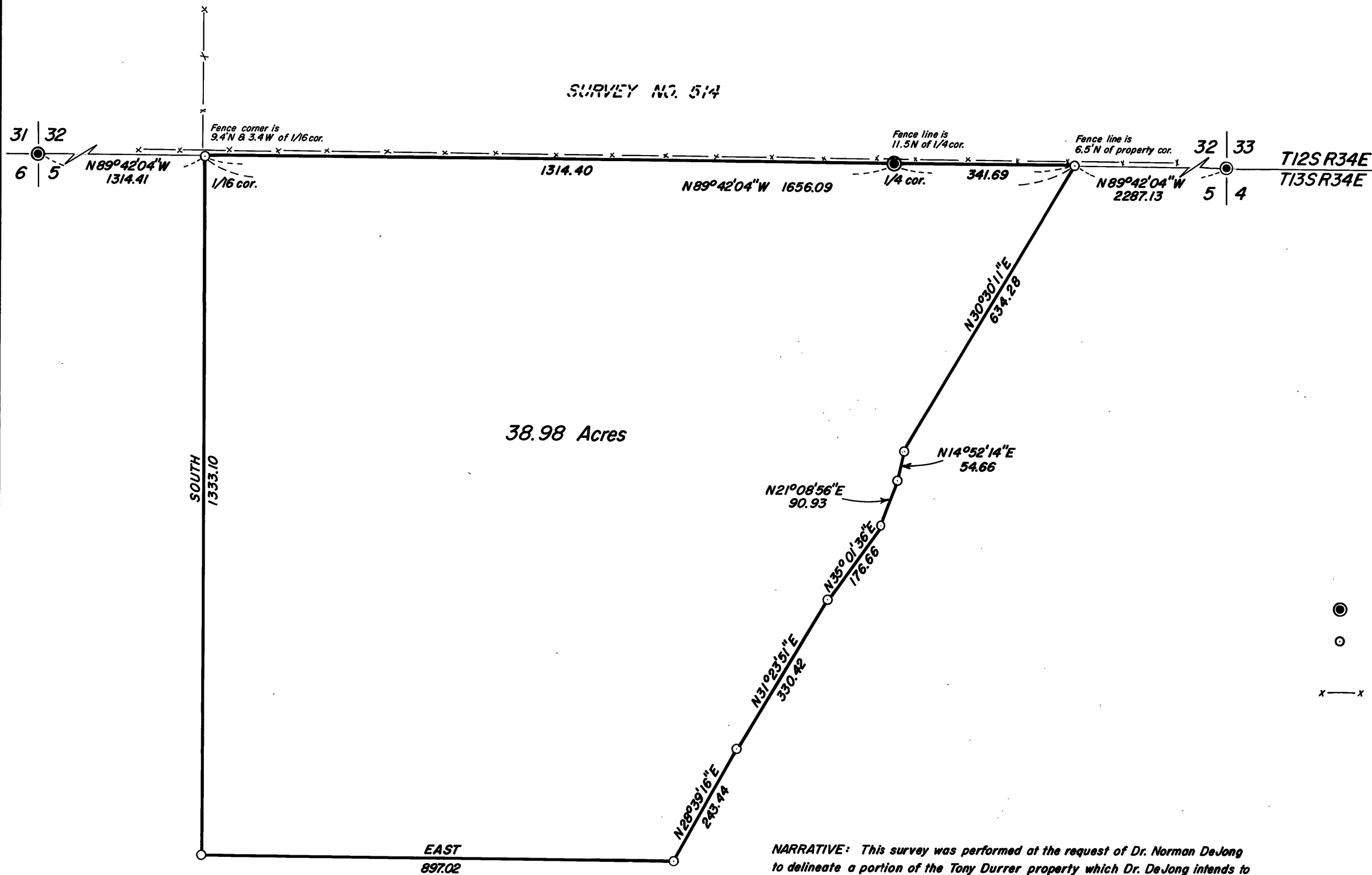
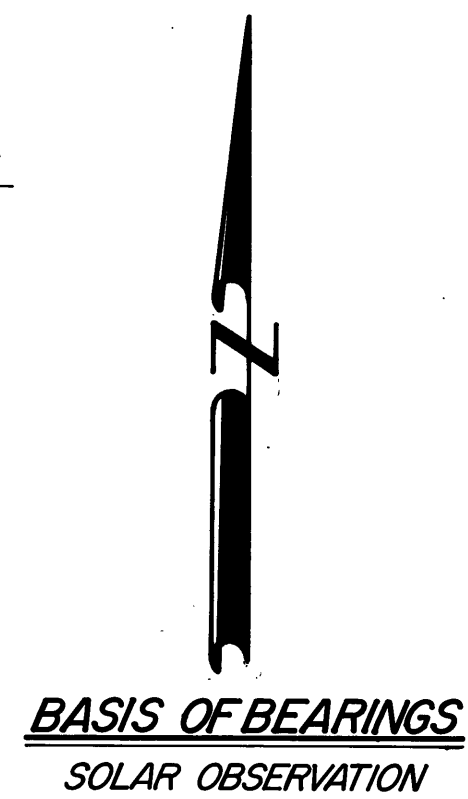

**NARRATIVE:** This survey was performed at the request of Dr. Norman DeJong to delineate a portion of the Tony Durrer property which Dr. DeJong intends to purchase. A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate existing monuments. New monuments were set in accordance with the evidence found as shown hereon. Since Mr. Durrer owned all of section 5, it was not necessary to subdivide the section for the purpose of this survey. The west and south lines of the tract shown hereon are not purported to be the west and south lines of government lot 3. This tract is described by a metes and bounds legal description. The north line of this tract is controlled by the north line of section 5, which I retraced and monumented in 1979 during survey no. 514. The east, west, and south lines of this tract were established by mutual agreement between Mr. Durrer and Dr. DeJong prior to this survey. I found no unusual conditions. See deeds vol. 122 page 918-919.
