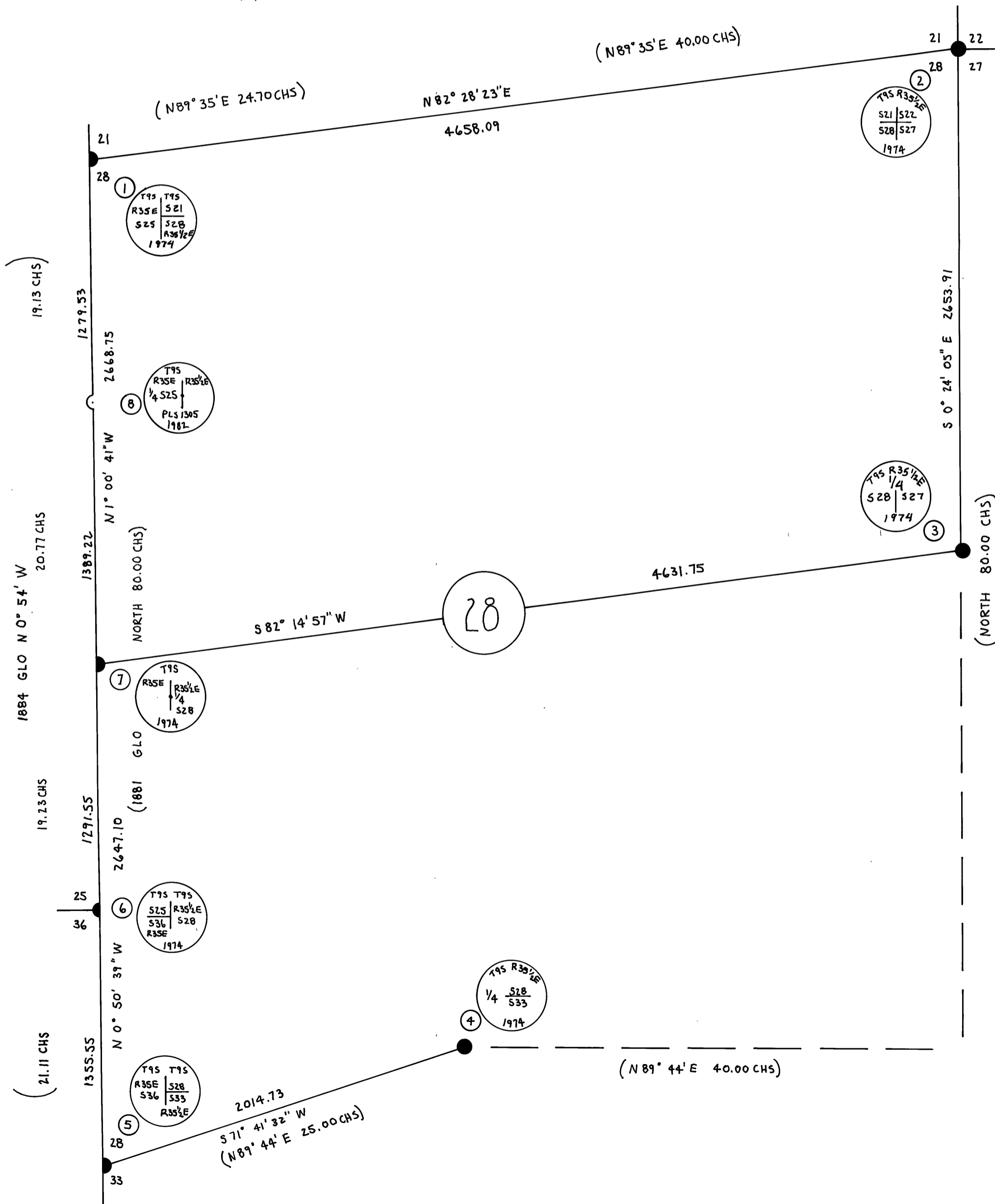
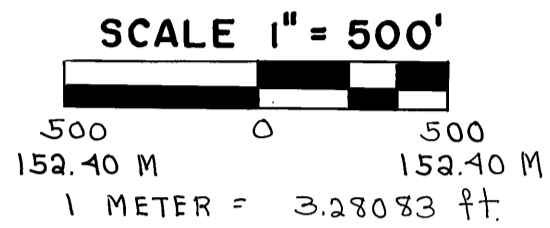
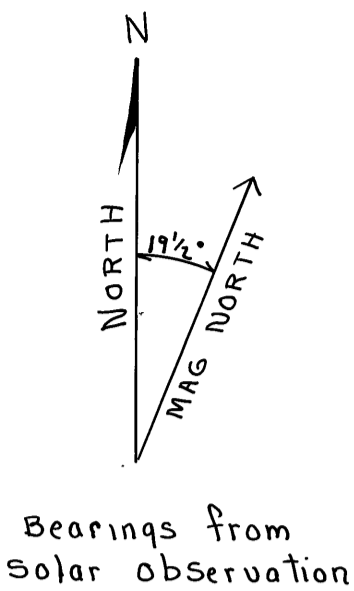

NOTE: ALL NEW BTS ARE FACED AND MARKED PER BLM MANUAL AND IN ADDITION HAVE A BRASS WASHER MARKED LS 1305 NAILED FLUSH IN LOWER BLAZE. ALL BTS ARE PAINTED WITH 6" RED BAND AND ARE TAGGED WITH APPROPRIATE SIGNS. ALL CORNERS SET ARE STAMPED PER BLM MANUAL PLUS THE TOWNSHIP, RANGE, 1982 AND PLS 1305. 6 FT. STEEL POSTS WITH APPROPRIATE SIGNS WERE SET 3 TO 5 FT. FROM ALL CORNERS AS PER CONTRACT. FIELD NOTES ARE IN BOOKS E, F, AND H CONTRACT NO. 53-04M3-2-2789.

NARRATIVE: THIS IS A CLOSED TRAVERSE BY A T-16 THEODOLITE AND DI-4 EDM, AND A T-1 THEODOLITE AND 300 FT. TAPE, MADE BY JACKSON & PROCHNAU, INC. P.O. BOX 177, ALBANY, OREGON 97321. BASIS OF BEARINGS IS A SOLAR OBSERVATION. THE EXTERIOR OF TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH RANGE 35 1/2 EAST WAS ORIGINALLY SURVEYED BY E.P. McCORNACK IN 1881 AND SUBDIVIDED BY W.B. BARR IN 1883. THE RANGE LINE BETWEEN RANGE 35 EAST AND RANGE 35 1/2 EAST WAS SURVEYED BY HERMAN D. GRADON IN 1884. THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25 TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH RANGE 35 EAST (CORNER NO. 8) WAS SET BY PROPORTIONAL MEASURE FOLLOWING A THOROUGH SEARCH OF THE AREA. THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 25 WAS REMONUMENTED ON THE RANGE LINE CONTROLLED BY THE 1881 McCORNACK SURVEY.
