 This survey represents the pertinent deed lines described in Book 89, Page 324, Deed Records of Grant County Oregon. In researching the records I discover an ambiguity in the deed description when comparing Book 89 Page 324 with Book 122 Page 37. This concerns the first course East of Elm Street. I held the courses and distances in Book 89, Page 324 because this deed is senior.
