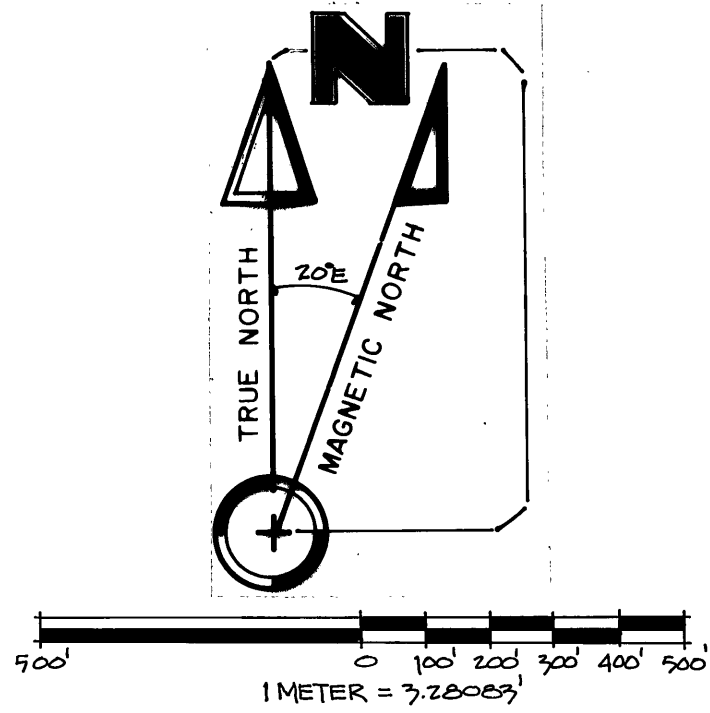


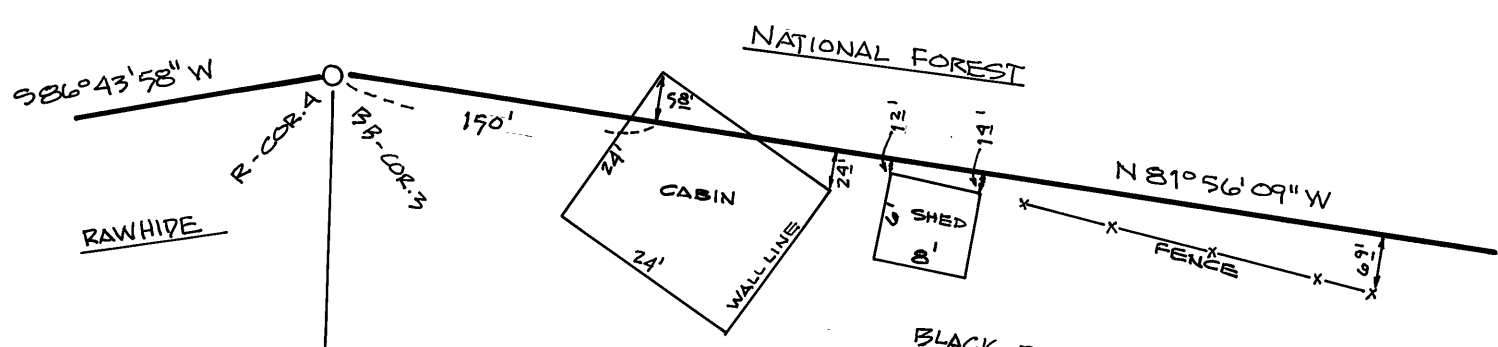
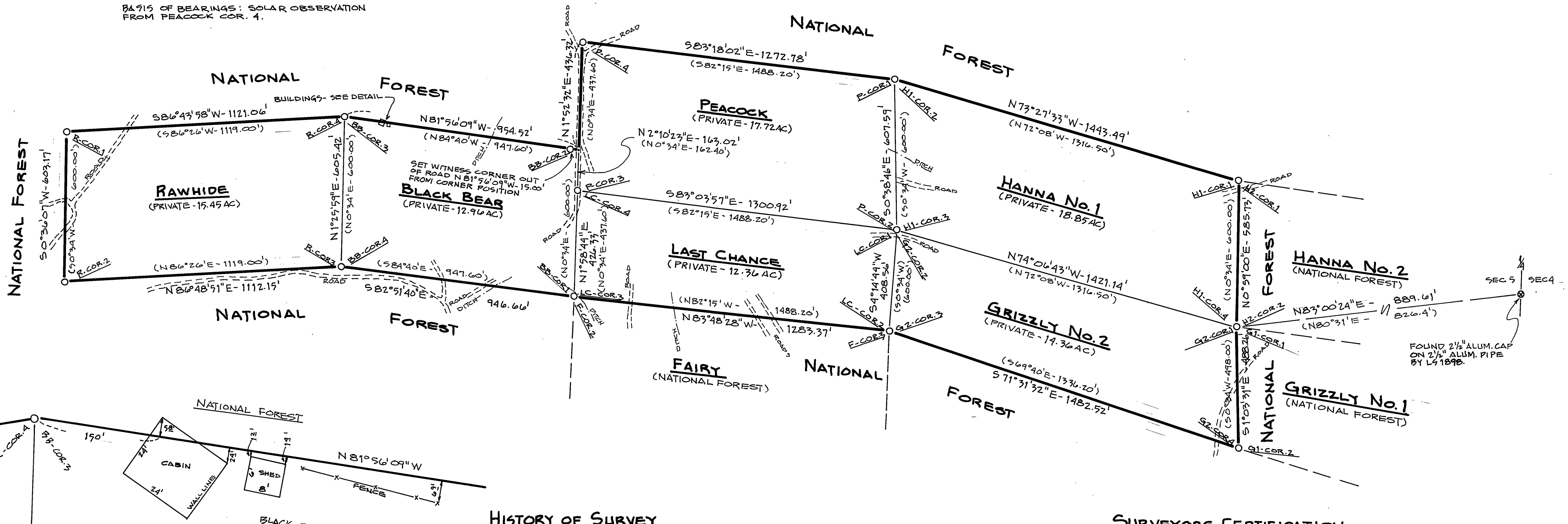
**PLAT OF A PART OF MS 528**

**HISTORY OF SURVEY**

MS 528 WAS ORIGINALLY SURVEYED BY LAYTON S. BALDWIN, U.S. DEPUTY MINERAL SURVEYOR, FOR THE GOLDBUG - GRIZZLY MINING COMPANY IN JUNE, 1907.

**NARRATIVE OF SURVEY**

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO RETRACE THE BOUNDARIES OF CERTAIN LOPE CLAIMS OF MS 528, TO RECOVER AND REMONUMENT ORIGINAL CORNERS, AND TO POST THE PRESENT NATIONAL FOREST BOUNDARY, AS INDICATED ON THE PLAT. ACCEPTABLE ORIGINAL EVIDENCE WAS FOUND FOR ALL REQUIRED CORNERS. END CENTERS WERE NOT ESTABLISHED AS PART OF THE ORIGINAL SURVEY. AS SHOWN ON THE PLAT, MAJOR DISCREPANCIES EXIST BETWEEN RECORD MEASUREMENTS AND ACTUAL MEASUREMENTS ON THE PEACOCK, HANNA No. 1, LAST CHANCE AND GRIZZLY No. 2. LOCES THE DIFFERENCES APPEAR CONSISTANT BUT THEY ARE SIGNIFICANT. THE POSITION PEACOCK CORNER 2 INDICATES THAT BALDWIN MAY HAVE "STUBBED" SOME OF THE CORNERS, ALTHOUGH TOPO CALLS APPEAR REASONABLE. WE ALSO NOTE FROM FOUND ORIGINAL POST REMAINS THAT BALDWIN MEASURED TO THE CENTER OF THE BEARING TREES RATHER THAN TO THE FACE OF BLAZE AS DID MOST MINERAL SURVEYORS OF THE DAY. OUR SURVEYS WERE PERFORMED WITH 1 SECOND THEODOLITE AND INFA-RED DISTANCE MEASURING EQUIPMENT.
